Come along and get creative designing stained-glass windows inspired by art nouveau and C.R. MacIntosh, or in fact any design you like!

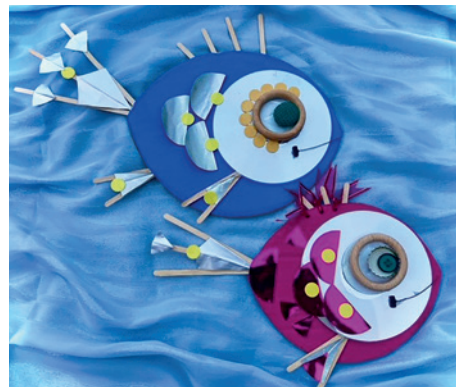


Fabulous Fish

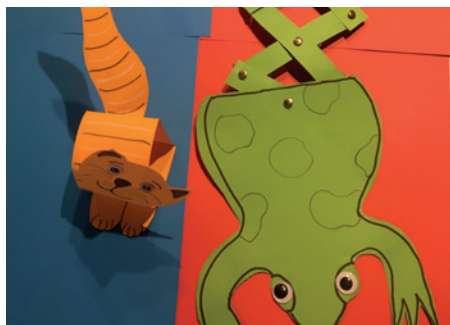

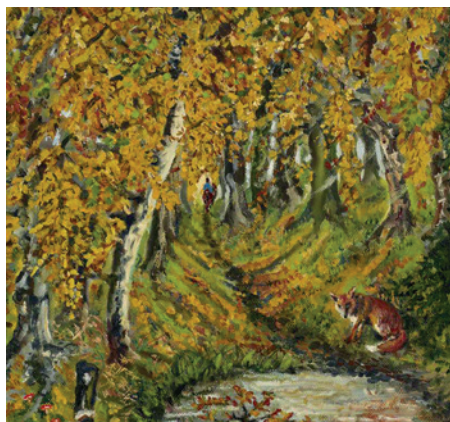
