

## **Elbow Grease**

# Session takes approx. 75 mins

Aim: To learn about homes in the past and how the majority of jobs were done by hand. To learn about the different objects that would have been used in the past.

#### Session breakdown

Whole class discussion. How do we tackle chores in the home today? Imagine a world before all our machines! Focus on the most challenging job – washing the clothes. The children are taken through each step of wash day, using original artefacts and role play.

### **Circus of Activities**

Dressed up in mop caps and aprons the children are challenged to do the wash day jobs! Children need to be in five groups so they can have a go with the historic objects: Ironing, Washing, Scrubbing, mangling, using the tongs and pegging the clothes.

### **Creative Activity:**

The session is concluded by the groups coming back together to make felt washing line pictures to take home.
