

How to make... Street Party Hats



YOU WILL NEED:

Scissor

Stapler

Glue stick

Sticky tape

Ruler

Pencil

Hole punch

A strip of thick paper or card, cereal box would work approx 60 x 15cm to fit around your head like a crown.

3 x A4 sheets different coloured paper (we used red, white and blue)

3 x barbecue skewers, or paper straws or lollipop sticks.

Approx 1m string, or wool, or thin ribbon.

- 1. Measure your strip of card so that it fits snuggly around your head like a crown. Staple or tape into place.
- 2. Using the coloured paper cut 9 little triangles, 3 of each colour, about 5cm along each edge. (Save the leftover paper)
- 3. Using the hole punch make a hole in the top 2 corners of each triangle. Thread the triangles onto your string, alternating the colours to make bunting.



- 4. Staple the mini bunting to your crown so that it drapes in 3 swags with 3 triangles on each.
- 5. Using sticky tape attach the barbecue skewers to your crown to make flagpoles. Using leftover coloured paper cut 3 different coloured strips, 3 x 8cm. (Save the leftover paper). Using a glue stick fold in half and glue a strip around the top of each flagpole to make 3 flags.
- 6. For the finishing touch make a V shape by folding a 12cm square of leftover coloured paper in half. With the fold on the left, cut a diagonal line from the bottom left to top right corner. Open out and cut a tiny triangle out of the middle top to make a V. Cut out and stick on a 75, or draw on if you prefer. Stick the V to the front of your crown.
- 7. Wear with flair!
