

How to make... *VE Day Medals*



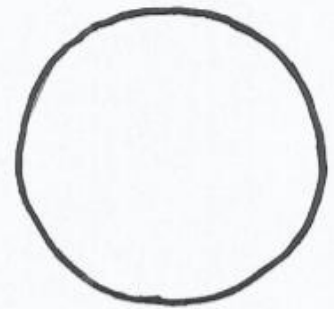
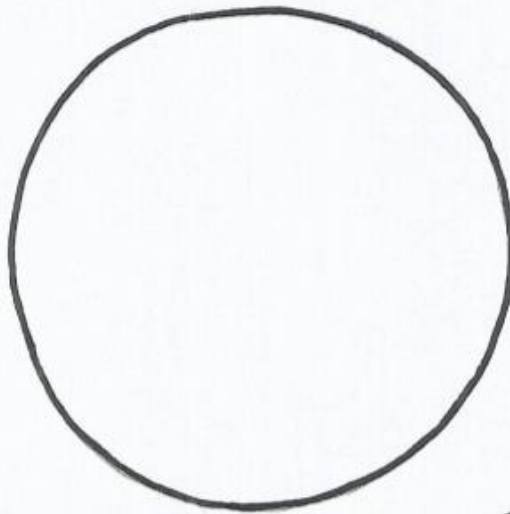
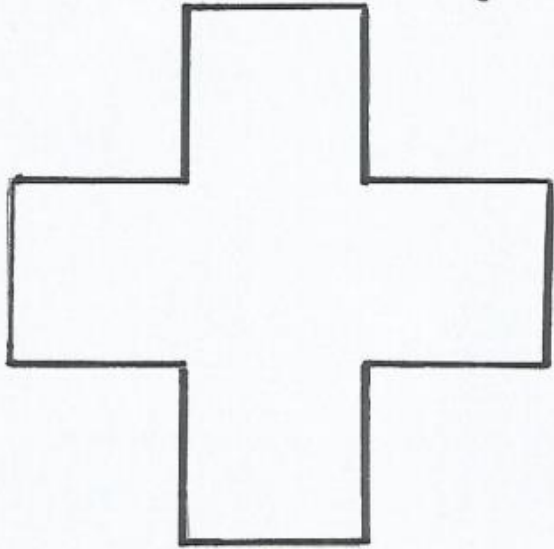
YOU WILL NEED

Cereal box card
Silver/gold foil
Thin ribbon
(red/white/blue)
Hole punch
Scissors
Glue stick
Sharp pencil

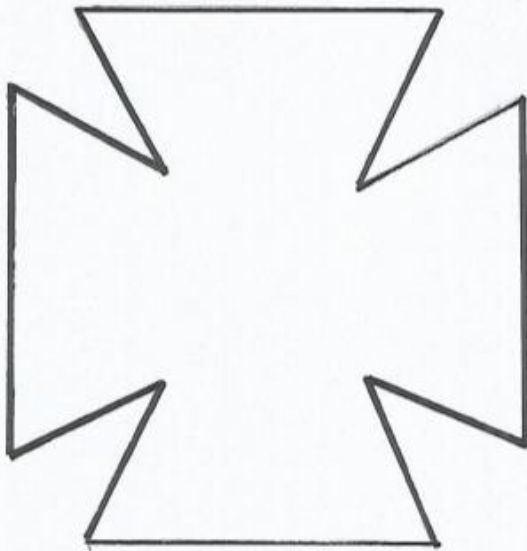
1. Firstly, choose your medal shape from the sheet of designs. Cut out and trace onto a piece of cereal box card. This will be your 'template' (your perfect shape) and you can use it to produce as many as you like.
2. If the shape is a simple one ie circle, star or GC, you'll be able to wrap the silver foil around it, and it will hold in place. If the shape is trickier, then trace your template straight onto the foil, cut it out very carefully, then glue it onto the template.
3. The tiny circle template is additional for if you wish to create an extra dimension (or embellishment) to your medal.
4. With a sharp pencil you can now 'score' into the foil (NB. don't press too hard or you might tear into the foil)
5. Finally use your holepunch to create a hole with which to feed your ribbon through. You could also attach a safety pin to wear it like a badge
6. Wear your medal with pride!



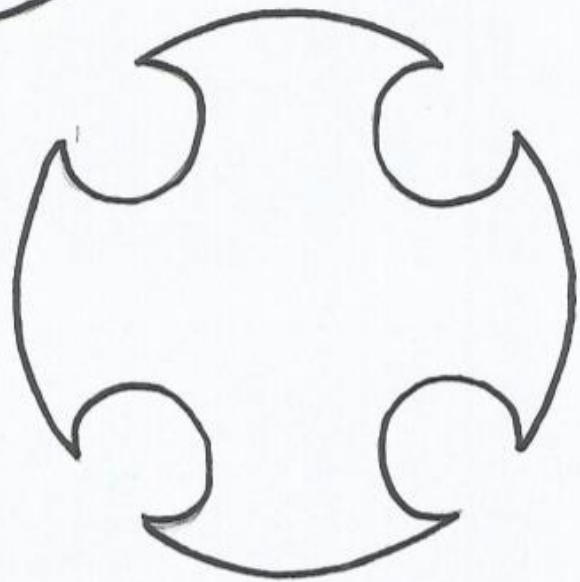
GEORGE CROSS (GC)
